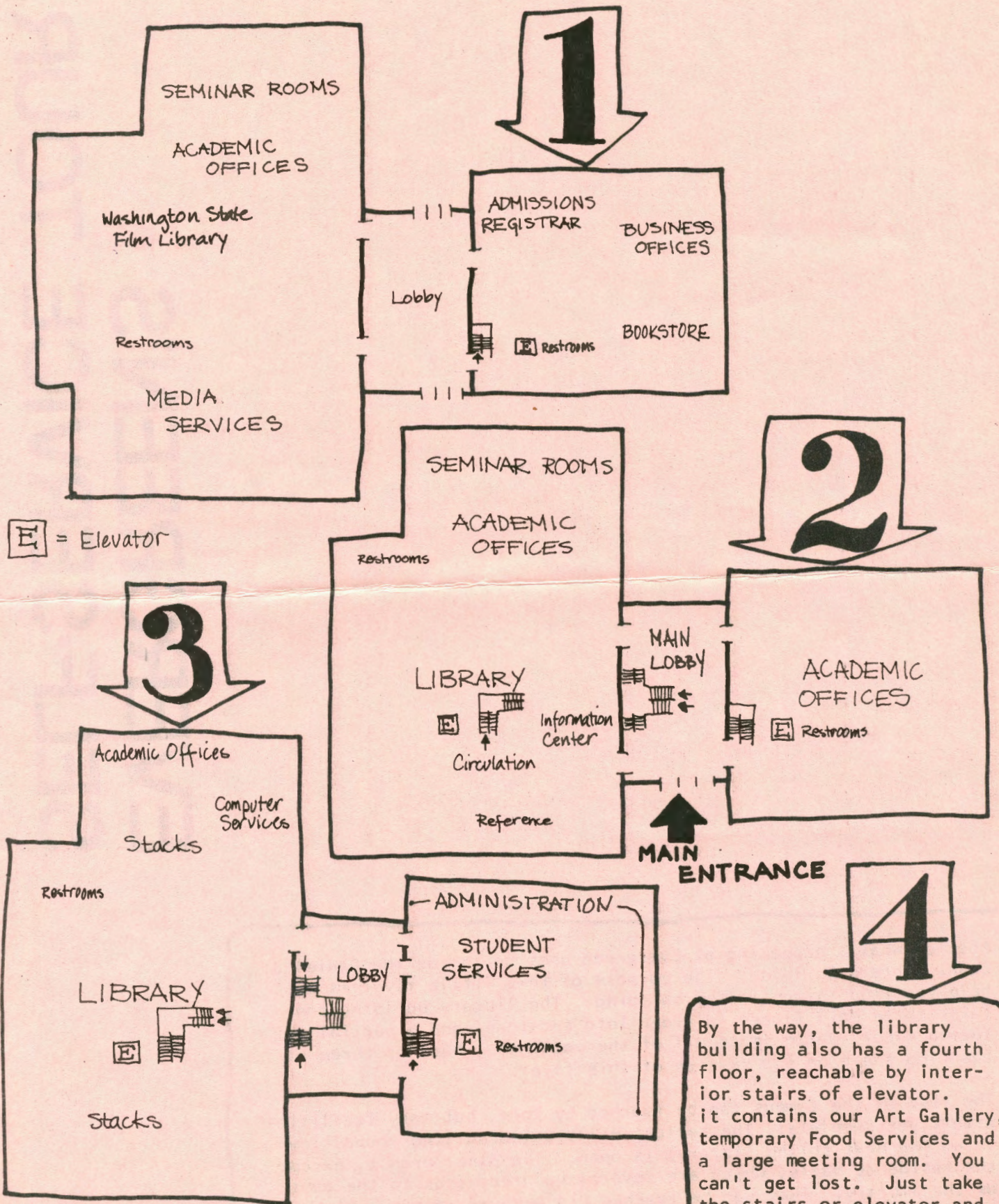

EVERGREEN'S SELF-SERVICE TOUR

Most of what's happening at Evergreen goes on inside the Daniel J. Evans Library Building. The purpose of this little flyer is to help you find things in the building. The library building contains three main floors (divided into sections) and a partial fourth floor, which spans all of the sections. Maps of three of the floors are on the reverse of this flyer.

The rest of the campus can be reached by foot, but many facilities aren't yet complete. The Lecture Halls Building (the round, low-lying one next to the library) is open. The other aren't, except the Residence Halls, which are several hundred yards to the east of the library. They can be reached via a paved pathway which begins outside the first floor area.
