Concerning: "The Farm"

The farm is to be an organic farm modeled after the Santa Cruz and the J.I. Rodale experimental farms. The potential activities which will coordinate with the farm are: animal husbandry (pigs, chickens, goats, etc.); carpentry (repairing buildings, constructing a greenhouse, etc.); home-making (spinning, weaving, food preserving, cooking, etc.); growing flowers (marigolds, etc.); and natural and agricultural studies. It is anticipated that other members of the College and the Community will become involved and that the farm will offer a full range of educational possibilities.

Our plans for the next few weeks are to evaluate the buildings, evaluate the land and plant life with the Evergreen Environment Group, and to survey the land.
