Randy has two brothers who sometimes fish together. This design represents the two men back to back, holding a net containing a salmon between them. They are standing on the gunwales of a canoe represented in cross-section.

Certificate of Authenticity

This print is a limited edition serigraph. Working with Randy's original cut rubylith stencils, I matched his samples for the two colors in Quinault Fishermen. The colors are then hand-printed onto archival paper. This print is one in an edition of 100 printed on Stonehenge Natural. In addition, 10 artists proofs and 3 printers proofs were printed on Stonehenge Natural for a total of 13 proofs. The paper size is 27" W. x 22" H. The image size is 21" W. x 18" H. The colors used were black and red. In addition, 8 artists proofs and 8 printers proofs were printed on Sugikawashi Cedar Bark paper.

This edition was printed by Paul Nicholson of Bellevue, WA in 1992 with the assistance of the artist, Randy Capoeman.
