

**SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:**

S1. Name of waterbody to receive herbicide treatment: Ken Lake. Adjuvants allowed, concentrations of herbicide, amounts, acre(s), and specific requirements including names of plants to be controlled under this Order are as follows:

**S2. Timing Requirements:**

A timing restriction is imposed limiting the application of any and all chemicals to the following period: Between June 27, 2001, and October 1, 2001.

**S3. Treatment Requirements:**

1.
  - a. Not to exceed .5 acres for cattail control.
  - b. Not to exceed 10 acres for pondweed control.
  - c. Not to exceed .5 acres for lily control.
  - d. Spot Treatment approved for algae control.
2. Do not treat for submerged and floating aquatic plants in undeveloped shorelines including areas that do not have houses, developed swim beaches or developed boat launch accesses.

**S4. Chemical Requirements:**

1. The following chemicals will be the only ones allowed for use under this Order, (for more detailed description see Specific Conditions: S1): copper compounds; glyphosate (Rodeo®); and endothall (Aquathol®).
2. No adjuvants shall be used by the applicator unless specifically allowed through this Order.
