

MINUTES OF FACULTY MEETING

February 22, 1971

1. Self-Paced Learning

In response to a proposal from the DTF on Workshops and Self-Paced Learning, the faculty agreed to devote the week of March 15 to a workshop on self-paced instruction. Activities will include: presentation of the DTF's final report, presentations on self-paced instruction and mini-course design, evaluation of commercially prepared and teacher-produced programs, and laboratory activities producing prototype materials e.g. segments of audio tapes, film clips and slides.

2. Shoben and Cadwallader lead an informative discussion which dealt with potential alcohol and drug problems, housing, community relations, and campus security.
3. Sluss and Crowe discussed their proposal that each Coordinated Studies team draw up a constitution for the internal governance and functioning of their program. This idea met with general approval.
4. Faculty research and teaching performance, degree requirements for candidates, representation of disciplines on the faculty and salary negotiations were thoroughly discussed.
5. In response to a question by Eickstaedt, Barry stated that the charge to the DTF on the Arts will be resolved by the Provost and Deans. He also stated that White's recommendation that 1% of building budgets be devoted to works of art will be forwarded to the President's Council.
