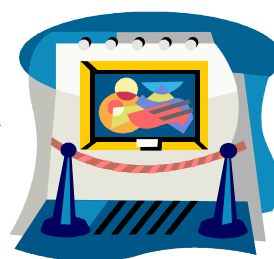

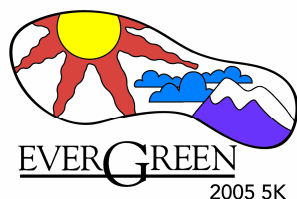
Reserve October 6, 2005 for the Friends Annual Meeting

Friends Sponsor Second Annual 5K Race



The Friends of the Evergreen State College Library will sponsor the 2nd annual Evergreen Classic 5K Race on Sunday, June 12 on the college campus.

The race is the culmination of various community events connected to Evergreen's traditional Super Saturday celebration.

The race begins at 9 a.m. at the Library Loop in front of Red Square. Runners and walkers will travel along a flat, fast course through the campus that ends back at the Library Loop. The race is USATF certified and sanctioned. Timing will be provided by Perfect Time Events.

Friends Provide Funds for Worthy Projects



The Friends of the Evergreen State College recently awarded grants to 28 seniors to help fund their senior projects. Ten students received awards of \$250 each for their Outstanding Submissions.

Another 18 students received Notable Submission awards of \$100 each. The funds will be used for a variety of projects in disciplines ranging from the sciences to the arts.

At their May meeting the Friends Board granted \$600 to support an initial translation project of the emerging web page for the Chicano/Latino Archive project. A local translation company, Spanish Pronto, has been contracted to do that work and will complete it by the end of June. The Board also agreed to fund a project to begin digitizing a series of literary recordings produced by the Library of Congress and purchased by the Library in the early 1980's. We will begin work in July to transfer the recordings from reel to reel audio tape to compact disc, thereby preserving the materials and making them available to researchers and scholars.

Awards will be given to the winners in the overall and masters divisions. The top three finishers in 13 age divisions will also be recognized. People of all ages are encouraged to participate.

The early entry fee is \$20 for people who pre-register and \$25 for those who register on the day of the race. The registration packet includes a tee shirt and sports bottle.

Library Re-Modeling Changes Book Sale

Due to the remodeling of the Library Building we will not build holding the traditional book sale at Super Saturday.
