To: DTF on Marine Facilities and Shoreline Planning

I would ask those named below to constitute a Task Force for the study and recommendation to me of appropriate actions relative to the development of Marine Facilities for the Evergreen fleet in the context of long range planning for our campus shoreline.

Considerable background material exists due to the work of previous Study Groups and DTFs. But, in fact, very little action has resulted from this earlier work. Now, however, we are faced with a growing fleet of Evergreen boats for both recreational and academic use and that waterfront is apt to see increasing use. Its value as an ecological and environmental laboratory is also recognized, along with increasing use of the beach by students for recreational purposes. Finally, with anticipated growth of the College and annual legislative sessions, we may now be able to get funding for some project work associated with a planned development of the waterfront.

I have asked David Wallbom, Director of Facilities, to do ~~some~~ preliminary proposal development to present to the DTF after you have had opportunity to review the work of the previous study groups (attached). The first meeting of the DTF will be held in the Board Room on Wednesday, November 28, 1979 from 1:00 - 3:00 PM. Please R.S.V.P. to my secretary at 366-6100.
