CURRENT STATUS

1. Legislature funded \$200,000 for Biennium.
2. Center will provide credit & non-credit educational programs (workshops/conferences/courses) to trade union members throughout Washington state.
3. Evergreen faculty member, Dan Leahy, will begin as full time Director for one year beginning September 15th.
4. A search committee will be established to recruit permanent Director for Fall, 1988.
5. A Labor Advisory Committee will be appointed by President Olander in the Fall to advise with planning/programming.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES: Programmatic

1. Monitor and Evaluate our Union Steward Training Program with the Seattle Machinists Union.
2. Follow up work to our just completed Summer School for Trade Union Women (June 18-June 21).
3. Develop a two year draft educational plan for the Center.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES: Organizational

1. Move into and equip new office space on 4th Floor of Seminar Building.
2. Prepare promotional materials about the general idea of Center .
3. Recruit at least one additional full time staff person.

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
