## *Hummingbird Moon*

Louie originally painted this Coast Salish Hummingbird design on a hand drum for a friend in 2010. The hummingbird is thought to be a harbinger of good news, carrying gentle reminders to enjoy the small things in life. This little hummingbird will bring you good energy as you go about your evening.

### *Certificate of Authenticity*

This print is a limited edition original serigraph. Working from Louie's drawings I cut rubylith stencils for the five colors. The colors are then hand-printed onto archival paper. The paper size is 15 inches wide and 19.5 inches tall. The image size is 11 inches wide and 16 inches tall. The inks used were light blue, dark blue, green, black, and red. This design was printed in an edition of 150 on Rising Stonehenge Warm White paper. In addition, 21 artist's proofs and 6 printer's proofs were made, also on Rising Stonehenge Warm White paper.

This edition was printed by Paul Nicholson of Bellevue, WA in 2015 with the assistance of the artist, Louie Gong.
