## *Heron Dance*

### *Artist Statement*

This print was designed to commemorate the Heronswood Totem Pole carved by Brian Perry and dedicated on March 14, 2015 at Heronswood Botanical Garden, Kingston, Washington. It depicts a male and female heron in a courtship dance.

### *Certificate of Authenticity*

This print is a limited edition original serigraph. Working from Brian's original drawings, Paul hand cut 3 rubylith stencils for the colors of "Heron Dance". The colors are (1) a blend of medium gray to light blue, (2) a dark transparent blue, and (3) a very dark gray. This print is one of an edition of 250 hand printed on Rising Stonehenge Natural paper. In addition, 25 artists proofs and 14 printers proofs were printed on Rising Stonehenge Natural, for a total of 39 proofs. The paper size of the Stonehenge is 16" wide and 14" tall. The image size is 11" W. x 10" H.

This edition was printed by Paul Nicholson of Bellevue, WA in 2015 with the assistance of the artist, Brian Perry.
