Joe also created this design for a square hide drum. The design honors the Squaxin tribal canoe families for their journeys to the annual gatherings.

#### *Certificate of Authenticity*

This print is a limited edition original serigraph. Working from Joe's original drawings, I cut rubylith stencils for the four colors. The colors are then hand-printed onto archival paper. The inks used were blue, yellow, red, and black. This print is one of an edition of 100 hand printed on Magnani Pescia pale blue paper. In addition, 3 printers proofs and 10 artists proofs were printed. The paper size is 19 inches wide and 14.5 inches tall. The image size is 17.5 inches wide and 13.5 inches tall.

This edition was printed by Paul Nicholson of Bellevue, WA in 2012 with the assistance of the artist, Joe Seymour, Jr.
