- -May 20^{th} approved requests \rightarrow Nancy Koppelman (publish a climate book and bring students on a field trip \$500 + \$82 for an Evergreen Van)
 - → essay of trip on website and someone would have to table for CEC

- -\$4000 for the Food Systems Working Group → Chair/Vice Chair positions for the Real Food Challenge (Presidential Committee)
 - -they have interviewed and hired, started training
 - -Yesha was present for the interviews
- -\$2, 785 for a Resource Manager to work with Scott Morgan in the Office of Sustainability
 - -sustainability tours, visibility → going to classrooms
 - -15 hours a week, half being covered by work study
- -All Approved for project applications
- -Facilities goals: once a month, publish energy usage for each building
 - -so people can see what they are using and how their actions make a difference
 - -could potentially be a competition
 - -replace any broken meters on the buildings
 - -hopefully within the year if not sooner
 - -more interactive to have it on site
- -Lab I/II floor by floor renovations since 1999
 - -looking at systems that are not addressed by floor by floor renovation (ex: seismic or HVAC)
 - -changing fluorescents to LEDs
- -Drive for CEC messages forwarded to Tom Mercado for approval of campus drive space
