Discussed Standards

24. **Knowingly assisting** another person to violate the Code or **failing to intervene with a violation** by, at a minimum, bringing the action to the attention of College officials.

Determined that it reflected College values in an action-orientation in the vein of an honor code. Determined to retain as written.

#7. Intentional **harm to self** which endangers the health, safety or wellbeing of the individual or others in the community.

Determined to retain despite addition of Required Medical Leave of Absence policy to options for addressed harm to self. Determined that it's important for the College to retain the option to address this via the Code, although the RMLA should be used most often.
