Meeting Notes

Michael facilitated review of sanctions.

Recommend the following:

**Warning**—A notice in writing that further misconduct may result in more severe sanctions.

**Probation**—A written reprimand for violation of specified policy. Probation is for a designated period of time and includes the probability of more severe disciplinary sanctions if the student is found to violate *any* institutional policy during the probationary period.

**Loss of Privileges**—Denial of specified privileges for a designated period of time.

**Restitution**—Compensation may be made to the college or to other person, groups or organizations for damages incurred as a result of prohibited conduct. This may take the form of appropriate service and/or monetary or material replacement.

**Educational Sanctions**—Service to the college, work assignments, essays, specific trainings or workshops, or other related educational assignments.

**Separation from the Residence Halls**—Separation of the student from the residence halls permanently or for a period of time (conditions for readmission may be specified).

**College Suspension**—Separation of the student from the college for a specified period of time. Conditions for readmission may be specified.

**College Expulsion**—Permanent separation of the student from the college which includes permanent trespass from College properties and/or attendance and involvement in college-sponsored activities or events.

We have several things we didn't touch on (the last two Model Code sanctions and the miscellaneous stuff from Evergreen's that we didn't discuss), and we may want to discuss putting any examples into Loss of Privileges to cover Evergreen's current (8).
