 - Issues of note may include:
 - Need for an accessible guide to the conduct process
 - Venue for peer adjudication of allegations
 - Resource to advise students of their rights and responsibilities when charged with a violation of the Code
 - Clarity and transparency of possible sanctions for misconduct
 - Codifying restorative justice practices/philosophy.

 - Review of Model Code – 4th meeting
 - Identify possible issues with current Code
 - Consult with constituents
 - Compare with Model Code

 - Discuss issues – Fall 08
 - Develop recommendations – Fall 08 & Winter 09
 - Vet recommendations – Winter 09
 - Finalize recommendations – Winter 09
