Debriefed Colleen Warren's comments from October 14.

- Colleen indicated that due to her workload it is unlikely she would be done with her review and guidance until February or March

Discussed expanding Jurisdiction.

- All members of the DTF recommend proceeding with expanded jurisdiction

Rationale: address conduct that could be harmful to the Evergreen community; make a values statement that we care about health and safety; may address retention of those who are victims

Examples: drug dealing off campus, physical assault to another member of the community, threat to harm self or others

- April will generate a draft that tries to address our concerns re: property damage

- Andi will bring copies of sister institution jurisdiction policy

- Wendy will draft FAQ re: Jurisdiction

- Stephanie noted need to change language re: who determines whether conduct off-campus is addressed to be more clear
