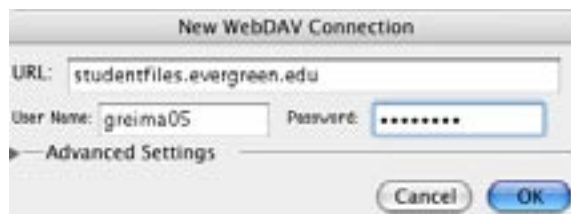


# DAV8 Goliath

## Connect to Evergreen's student file server using Goliath

Goliath is an application that allows Mac OS X users to remotely upload and download files from Evergreen's file servers. Goliath is an Open Source project and is free to download and use.

1. Download Goliath from <http://www.webdav.org/goliath/> and copy the application folder into your Applications Folder
2. Launch Goliath
3. enter the URL of the student files server: studentfiles.evergreen.edu
4. enter your Evergreen username and password (see below)
5. click OK
6. Navigate to your program's shared directory in the Programs folder OR your individual directory located under the lettered directory corresponding to the first letter of your login (or lastname).
7. You can now use Drag and Drop in the Goliath window to copy files back and forth between your computer and the student file server.
8. To save your Goliath connection settings so the next time you can access your folder with a single click go File > Save Settings.
9. When you're done working, make sure to close your connection File > Close or quit Goliath.

Formula	Example	
1st 3 characters of your last name	gre	
1st 3 characters of your first name	ima	
2 digit day of the month you were born	05	
username =	greima05	
2 digit day of the month you were born	05	
1st 3 characters of the month you were born in (lowercase)	jul	
2 digit year you were born	80	
default password =	05jul80
