Spend at least 48 hours with the MiniDisc recorder (or cassette recorder if you want a more analog quality sound. Media Loan has an array of older marantz cassette recorders, some with phone inputs for recording phone conversations). Or you may want to pick one up once a week over the quarter, or keep one with you for a week. Give yourself a time constraint or schedule for making your audio diary and stick to it.

Your diary audio may be a soundtrack that goes with your diary film, or you may choose to create an audio diary piece separate from the diary film.

Remember that a diary need not be based on your voice at all, or on your voice alone.

You will edit your audio piece in PeakDV and DP4.
