**Lesson Title: Reservation Relocation #1** 

Grade Level: 4th

#### **Related Standards:**

### **Objective:**

After comparing maps that show the location of tribes before and after treaty signings and a discussion on how these changes would have affected the living situation of the tribes SWBAT identify three changes the tribes would have faced and how those changes would have affected their traditional way of life.

#### **Materials:**

Maps

White/Chalk board

#### **Room Arrangement:**

Small groups

#### **Procedures:**

Introduce that before the treaties were signed the native tribes of Washington lived throughout the northwest

Have students look at maps that show the lands that native tribes once inhabited, and reservations that were established by treaty agreements between the U.S, government and Indian tribes. Have them talk in their small groups about what changes they see between the two maps. Have each group come up with a list of things they think would have changed.

Have groups share with the whole class. Write possible ideas on the board, having students expand and explain as needed. Ask for ideas about how these changed would have affected the native tribe's daily life. (if the students are stuck ask about food, shelter, trade, medicine, natural resources).

After the whole group discussion have students write down three changes and how those changes would have affected the tribe's daily way of life.
