

## Workshop on Quechua morphology

The following data illustrate Quechua verbal morphology:

rantini	I buy (it).
rantin	S/he buys (it).
rantinchis	We buy (it). (inclusive 'we')
rantiyku	We buy (it). (exclusive 'we')
rantinku	They buy (it).
rantishan	S/he is buying (it).
rantiran	S/he bought (it).
rantiwan	S/he buys me. (or, 'She buys (it) for me.')
rantikun	S/he kindly buys (it).

A. Identify morphemes with the following meanings:

buy  
s/he  
they  
I (1st person singular subject)  
me (1st person singular direct object)  
kindly  
*progressive marker* ("is...-ing")

B. Translate into Quechua:

I bought (it).  
We (inclusive) are buying (it).  
They bought me.  
They kindly bought (it).

C. What complications arise in determining the following forms?

They are buying me.  
They kindly bought (it).
