Animating Text with Photoshop

- 1. Create a new file in Photoshop that adheres to DV video dimensions.
 - a. Go File > New
 - b. from the dropdown choose Film and Video
 - c. Choose NTSC DV
- 2. Create a layer for each object you want to animate
- 3. Go Window > Animation to open the animation window
- 4. To animate a layer
 - a. From the animation window click the stop watch next to the property you want to animate
 - b. Move the timeline scrubber to the next point in the timeline
 - c. Change the value of your layer property (if using the position property, use the move tool to move the layer)
 - d. Repeat for each layer and property you want to animate
- 5. To export to Quicktime choose File > Export > Render Video
 - a. You will probably want to review the **Settings** for the video you are about to render
