We have dedicated some program time (on Thu. Jan. 26) for you to work on putting together your research and performance teams. The deadline for submitting your Group Membership List is Mon. Jan. 30 at noon (note this is deadline is postponed from the original plan).

To make the in-class time most effective, we ask that you:

- post your Individual Statement (described below) to the dedicated forum (link available on the Week 13 Calendar page) by 3 pm Wed. Jan. 25
- read through as many of your colleagues' responses as you can before the dedicated in-class session on Thu. Jan. 26, taking notes and replying directly when you are interested

We have set up a link at the Week 13 Calendar page for Wed. Jan. 25 to a dedicated forum for you to post your Individual Statement and begin discussions with other program members about your research interests & skill sets.

Your Individual Statement should be as brief as possible while including information about:

- 1) What is interesting and/or important to you about a science play
- 2) Your research/topic interests
- 3) Strengths you bring to a working group
- 4) Knowledge and skills you hope to develop through your group work
- 5) Other issues or items you think are important

In forming working groups, in addition to shared interests, you should consider:

- the knowledge and skills that each member brings that will help the entire group develop research and performance skills;
- working styles that inspire you to learn more about things you don't already know and learn to do things you don't already know how to do;
- other individual and group outcomes and products described in the Research & Performance Project overview we discussed the first day of class (available at the Week 11 Calendar page)
